JOB PURPOSE

- Represent the interests of the AgForce Commodity Board and its policies in the broader community

- Provide leadership for the Region
- Lead the Regional Council in support of the objects, vision and purpose of AgForce, the Terms of Reference of which are set out as part of the regional Handbook
- Chair the Regional Council Meetings
- Work collaboratively with the AgForce CEO and Regional team
- Enable regional perspectives to be considered by the Board and lead regional policy discussions with a view to making Policy recommendations.
- Participate actively in the regions in which they represent, including attendance to as many regional events as possible
- Uphold standards of behaviour as outlined in the Code of Conduct for Regional Presidents
- Comply with AgForce Policies and Procedures contained with the Governance Manual
- Promote membership of AgForce
- Regional Presidents may or may not be the Regional Director
